



Supplemental Home School Program

Grades 5-6



The Supplemental Home School Program is a unique learning opportunity for elementary students. Designed to be a co-operative effort between parent and teacher, we will meet Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9am-3pm. The class will be taught primarily by Curt and Jenny Bumcrot.

Program Description:

The following subjects will be taught by Curt Bumcrot:

Bible: A brief Scripture reading linked to the church year will be read and explained, followed by prayer each morning.

Math: We will be using Saxon Math Grade 5 and Level 1 (grade 6). Parents are required to purchase their student's math textbook. We will also be using Marcy Cook Math Centers. Marcy Cook is a Master Educator, author, and math specialist. Her centers provide high level thinking encounters, individual skill building, and problem solving. Students will be required to do homework on the days they do not attend class.

Grammar and Language Mechanics: *Bob Jones English 5* and *Mastering Punctuation*.

Writing: Paragraph writing, essays, creative writing, and poetry. The goal is to improve each student's writing skills and love of writing!

The following subjects will be taught by Jenny Bumcrot:

Social Studies: To be determined.

Spelling: Evan Moor's *Building Spelling Skills* correlated to Common Core state standards. Supplemental phonograms will be taught to reinforce spelling skills using *The Writing Road to Reading*.

Literature: We will read a variety of age appropriate books with study guides from Veritas Press or Progeny Press, including *The Golden Goblet*, *Door in the Wall*, *Anne of Green Gables*, and *The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe*.

Art: Art teacher Patty Palmer has written an amazing art curriculum called *Deep Sparkle*. Her lessons are fun, kids love them, and I have enjoyed using this curriculum. Fun, creative, messy art projects every week!

Drama: Improvisation and creativity will be explored through a variety of games and teamwork to perform dramatic presentations. Taught by Natalie Trust twice a month.

Times and Fees:

Time: Tuesdays & Thursdays, 9:00am – 3:00pm. Classes will begin Tuesday, September 5, 2017

Tuition: \$225 per month (9 months)

Materials Fee: \$250

Application Fee: \$100 (A CAT/TerraNova 2 achievement test will be administered prior to enrollment at no charge.)

To Apply:

- Registration for new students opens April 3rd. All application components must be received to secure your spot.
- Complete all sections of the *Application for Admission*.
- Complete the *Immunization form*. Your student's vaccination record must be current or exempt. If your student is dually enrolled, please notify our office and you will not need to complete the Immunization form.
- Return the above to Basic Skills with the *application* and *materials* fees, payable to Basic Skills. All account balances for any Basic Skills products or services must be current for this application to be processed.
